Dear Praying Friends,

We Survived: Angela and I have completed eight weeks of intensive Estonian language classes. How much have we learned? We have complete fluency when talking to any two-year-old Estonian! We do have a solid foundation of Estonian grammar, and we are eager to continue learning the language this January.

Cyber Warriors: Since the invasion of the Republic of Georgia by Russia, Georgian government websites have come under "cyber attack" just as Estonia was in April 2007. To show their support, Estonia has sent two "cyber defense experts" to help Georgia in this crisis. Apparently, the Estonians have become the authority on cyber warfare!

Georgian Ministry Opportunity: On August 7, 2008, Russia invaded Georgia claiming to be in support of minority groups who desire independence from Georgia. As a result of the invasion, a great humanitarian crisis has been created. Thousands lack food and other basic needs. Because of this crisis, the EurasiaOutreach Team is launching our first major project in the former Soviet Union.

Team member Andrew Bunnell, along with BIMI European Field Director Brant Holladay, have a good relationship with a dynamic indigenous Baptist church near Tbilisi, the capital of Georgia. Our plan is to provide these believers with the ability to meet tangible needs during this time of great desperation in their country. If these believers can be seen by their countrymen to be reaching out in compassion at this critical time, this will open a great and effectual door of ministry both now and in the future within the Republic of Georgia. We are asking churches that desire to make a difference for the sake of the Gospel in Georgia to take advantage of this great opportunity!
