Dear Pastors, Churches, Fellow Saints and Praying Friends:

Greetings in the name of our Lord and Savior, Jesus Christ. It is our hope that your Spring has been blessed. We pray that you are looking forward to Christ's continued blessings as we transition into Summer. We are sending you this letter to provide you an update on our missionary activities for the month of May.

Christ has blessed us with the ability to present our work in four churches this month accumulating over 3900 miles of driving since our last report. To date, we have presented our work in 8 churches with over 12,800 miles driven. Thus far, the Lord has taken us on our deputation travels to churches in Texas, Illinois, New Jersey, and Oklahoma. Our deputation meetings for the coming months will have in California, Maryland, Pennsylvania. Our spiritual results have seen over 100 gospel tracts passed to people in restaurants, truck stops, and fast-food drive thru windows. We have had at least two individuals inquire of us about being missionaries and how to help missionaries beyond their giving.

It is safe to say that Christ has given us little victories and blessings this month as we endeavor to serve Him through our deputation ministry. We have also had some disappointments, but we can empathize with the Apostle Paul in 2 Corinthians 4:16-17:

(16) For which cause we faint not; but though our outward man perish, yet the inward man is renewed day by day. (17) For our light affliction, which is but for a moment, worketh for us a far more exceeding and eternal weight of glory;

We believe Christ is using us to encourage and challenge our fellow saints as we present our burden and discuss missions and missionary work. It is our hope that the seeds of revival are being planted in hearts as we outline the plight of the lost and the need for winning them to Christ. We know that our labors are not in vain in the Lord (1 Cor. 15:58).
