Statement of Faith

The Bible

I believe that the Bible is the verbally inspired Word of God. I believe that He used men to pen those words under the inspiration of the Holy Spirit. I believe that the King James Version is the preserved Word of God for the English-speaking people and is the version that I will use in my ministry. (Psalm 12:6–7; 2 Timothy 3:15–17; 1 Peter 1:23–25; 2 Peter 1:19–21)

Jesus Christ

I believe that Jesus Christ is God in the flesh and the only Savior of mankind. I believe He came to earth as the son of the Virgin Mary, lived a sinless life, and offered Himself on the cross as a substitutionary sacrifice for the sins of all mankind. I believe that His death on the cross is the only way to an eternal heaven. I believe He resurrected bodily and ascended into Heaven where He now resides until His return. (Isaiah 7:14, 9:6, 43:11; John 1:1, 3, 14, 18, 29; Romans 3:19–25; Romans 5:6–15; Philippians 2:5–11; 1 Thessalonians 4:13–18; 1 Timothy 2:5, 3:16; Titus 2:10–15; Hebrews 7:26, 9:24–28; 1 Peter 1:19, 2:2; 1 John 1:3; Revelation 20:1– 6)

The Holy Spirit

I believe the Holy Spirit of God is an equal person of the Godhead who is presently indwelling and directing those who are saved along with advancing the gospel in the world. The Holy Spirit is sent to regenerate, sanctify, seal, and indwell all who have placed their faith in Jesus Christ. (Genesis 1:2; Matt. 28:19; John 3:5–6, 14:16; Acts 1:5, 11:15; 1 Corinthians 3:16, 6:19– 20; 1 Corinthians 12:13)

Sin and Salvation

I believe all men were born with an inherited sin nature received from our common ancestor, Adam. I believe that because of his nature, man is a sinner by choice, and he is totally incapable of reforming himself or ceasing from his sin by his own power. I believe the only hope of deliverance for man is a total change of mind concerning his sinful condition and inability to change it, and a turning to Jesus Christ as the only Savior. I believe that only through the substitutionary sacrifice of Christ on the cross can a man be delivered from his sin. I believe that all those who reject Jesus Christ as their Savior are already condemned to an eternity in the lake of fire. (Genesis 5:1-5; Acts 4:19; Acts 16:31; Romans 3:10-23; Romans 5:6-12; Romans 6:23; Romans 10:9-10; Ephesians 2:8-9; Titus 3:5-6; Revelation 20:11-14)

The New Testament Church

I believe the local church is Christ's institution for advancing His gospel and doing His work in the world. The church is made up of those who have been saved and biblically baptized (Acts 2:4; Col. 2:13; Matt. 3:13-17) uniting and faithfully gathering together for the purposes of Bible teaching, worship, prayer, fellowship, service, and observance of baptism and communion. This body is autonomous in nature. (Col. 1:18; 2nd Cor. 8:1-8; Matthew 16:16–18; Acts 1:15, 2:41–43, 11:15, 20:28; 1 Corinthians 15: 51–58; Ephesians 1:12–14, 5:25–30; 1 Thessalonians 4:13–18; 1 Timothy 3:4–15)

Separation

I believe that a Christian should grow in grace, living a life that is becoming of the gospel and honoring to Jesus Christ—properly reflecting His love and holiness. I believe in separating from biblical heresy and from sinful, self-destructive, and immoral behavior. (Romans 12:1–2, 14:13; 2 Corinthians 6:14–7:1; 2 Timothy 3:1–5; 1 John 2:15–17; 2 John 9–11; Leviticus 19:28; 1 Corinthians 6:19–20)

End Times

I believe in the literal interpretation of the Scriptures in context and with a dispensational view of prophecy. I believe that following timeline of future events will go as follows: first, the rapture of the church, followed by a seven-year tribulation and the return of Jesus to the earth, followed by His literal rule of one thousand years ending with the Great White Throne Judgment, culminating with the creation of a new Heaven and new earth. (1 Corinthians 15:51–58; 1 Thessalonians 4:13–18, 5:1–9; Revelation 19–22)

Giving

I believe that every Christian is a steward of the material gifts of God entrusted to him. This generosity should be driven by grace (not obligation), empowered by gratitude, and should flow from a willing and cheerful heart for the development of the church and advancement of the gospel. I believe that God did however institute a giving requirement of ten percent of the firstfruits He gives us. (Genesis 14:20; Proverbs 3:9–10; Acts 4:34–37; 1 Corinthians 16:2; 2 Corinthians 9:6–7; Galatians 6:6; Ephesians 4:28; 1 Timothy 5:17–18; 1 John 3:17)


