I trust that the Lord has been good to you all because He sure has been good to us. God showers us with His blessings in ways we don't expect it. You all have been in our thoughts and prayers.

We have had to alter a few plans on our schedule due to health and the COVID-19 lockdowns and restrictions, but that has not kept us from serving God. Candidate school with BIMI was schedule for the first week of August, but has been rescheduled for December 7-11. Despite this change, BIMI has been a great help to us already. They have giving me access to a list of their Kentucky churches. They have also given us a lot of helpful tips and advice to experience success throughout deputation. We're very grateful for their friendship. Over the last two months we had five meetings, three in Kentucky and two in Pennsylvania. From August 23- September 20 we have already been able to book six meetings, five in Kentucky and one in Virginia.

Seven weeks ago, I got to reassure my seventeen year old brother of his salvation. Right after his reassurance, he made a decision to give his life to the Lord and to attend Bible college. He has started attending my home church, Frederick Baptist Church, in Maryland and we have been studying the Bible together once a week. He and I have also been working on winning a few of his friends to Christ. He has a year of public school left before he goes to Bible college and he's already facing some resistance from family members over his decision. Please pray that God will give him the strength to endure, to keep the fire burning in his heart, and for continued spiritual growth. His name is Noel.

We had a meeting in Appalachia Kentucky, but before we went I did some some research on the region and found that it is one of the poorest regions in the United States.
