Over the course of the last two months, the Lord blessed us with opportunities to present our ministry to seven churches. One of those churches has partnered with us and we should be hearing back from some shortly. We are now hovering around 12 percent in support. We attended a missions conference in early September and after presenting our work, speaking specifically about translating the KJB into Asante Twi for the Ghanaians, a man approached us and offered to print those Bibles for us (free of charge) when the translation is complete. It is simply amazing to see God lining things up when we remain faithful.

Three weeks ago, my barber, who is a Jehovah's Witness, asked me what I believed about Jesus Christ. I told that I believe that He's the only begotten Son of God and Through Him we have salvation. I also showed him from the Bible how we know these things. He showed me what the JW text said and it completely contradicted the KJV. I walked away thinking that our conversation was not entirely fruitful, but the next day he messaged me wanting to hear more of what I had to say about Christ.
