In Nyamula the work is progressing little by little. It has been an encouragement to see more people coming to the Bible study than in our previous updates. Annola Adroph, whom we mentioned in the last letter, has continued to come to the Bible study and as well others, who have made themselves regular attendees. One family that has started attending is the Jani family. We went to their house for several weeks during our Saturday soul winning time to witness to them. We praise the Lord that each one in this family made a choice to trust Christ as their Saviour. There are about five adults from this home that have attended the Bible study, but Happy and his wife Dorothy have come almost every week since the time they professed Christ as their Lord and Savior. Pray that we will continue to see them faithfully attend and also grow in their faith. Please be praying for the work here in this village as we prepare for our first baptism and form the membership of the church in Nyamula.



Please continue to pray for the children's ministry here and all the work that Jessica and our oldest kids do to bring these young people to Christ.

During these past few months we have also started having some of the faithful men of the Phokera church preach. We have Bakali, Samson, Den, Brighten, and Anold all taking turns preaching during Bible study on Wednesdays. These men all have willing hearts and a strong desire to serve the Lord. Right now it is evident that they are still novices and are in need of maturing in their understanding, as well as in their ability to preach and teach. Please pray for these men as we mentor them, and seek to prepare them to serve the Lord.

We also ask you to continue to pray for our family. Everyone is happy and healthy as we serve the Lord here together. Anna is already almost finished with her freshmen year of college! Lydia is not far behind Anna. She is already enrolled in early enrollment Bible college courses while she finishes her senior year of high school. The rest of the children are also all growing up very quickly. Pray for each of them that they would continue in their desire to serve the Lord with their lives.

Last, our current immigration papers give us until April 30, 2026. Because of this we will be starting the process to get another two year extension on our employment papers from the immigration office. Please pray that we can get these extensions easily and without any problems.
