We were able to purchase a vehicle 2 new visiting families Dear Friends,

The days and weeks since our last update have flown by. We continue to settle in and become adjusted to living in New Zealand. While America is looking forward to a beautiful springtime, we have watched the leaves change into the beautiful fall golds, reds, and yellows to them falling leaving the branches barren and brown. The grass is still green, and we have flowers that continue to bloom even in 30- and 40-degree weather. We had our first frost a few days ago. The weather continues to be fairly bleak in the mornings but by midday the sun has burned away the clouds and we enjoy high 50's and a light breeze.

We met several of our neighbors and invited them to church. No one has yet accepted our invitation, but we are looking forward to seeing them one day at church.

We were able to do some letterboxing in the area around our current meeting place for Sunday morning services. We put 1,000 Easter flyers in the letterboxes. Unexpectedly, Easter Sunday was less attended than many of our Sunday morning services. While it was disappointing, we know that we were obedient in reaching out to our community and will continue to do so.

We are meeting at a Senior Centre here for our Sunday morning services and then we hold Sunday evening and Wednesday evening services in our home. Our Sunday morning services are hovering near 55 on average, which is a blessing.

We fill up our living room and kitchen on Sunday and Wednesday evenings for church services, which is very encouraging. We average around 30

for each service. Recently, we started a Family Quiz Contest on Sunday evenings that involves each family in the church. We started out in Genesis and asked the families to read three chapters a week. On Sunday evening I ask 5-6 questions from each chapter. Whoever answers the question correctly receives a point for their family. At the end of the quarter, the family with the most points will take home a trophy. They keep the trophy for the next quarter. They have really enjoyed the contest.

Every other Tuesday, we host a ladies Bible study in our home. This is a time for the ladies to share with each other something from their personal devotions through the week. The men rotate between house on the opposite Tuesday evenings. It has been a blessing discussing what God is teaching us through His Word.

I have begun discipling one of our teens. We spend about an hour and a half each week working through the discipleship program. I am excited to see his growth.
