Hello from New Zealand,

Thank you for your patience as this prayer letter has been delayed. We try to get our letters out every two months, and it has been a while. My sincerest apologies.

We have entered springtime here for which we are extremely grateful. The winters can be pretty cold. Still, our days are in the 80's and nighttime will get into the 40's or 50's.

Our prayers are with those in the US right now who have been affected by hurricane Helene and Hurricane Milton.

In August, Josh Zacharias came over from Australia and was used of God to teach a soul-winning seminar to our church and other churches in the area. Since then, we have seen God bring in visitors from around the Ashburton area. Our attendance has been steady for which we are grateful. This past Sunday we needed to add more chairs to accommodate several who came in after the service began. We were thrilled by this.

My (Brett) brother was diagnosed early this year with lung cancer and was told it was stage 3 just because of the location. He began chemo and radiation and when those treatments were complete, he began immunotherapy treatments. After the third treatment, a CT scan was performed which revealed another cancerous nodule on his left lung, right hip and adrenal glands. The cancer has already begun to bore into the bone on his right hip and leg; however, the doctors have said that with treatment they should be able to kill that cancer, and the holes will fill in. When this was announced, I took a brief trip to the US to see him and spend some time with him and my parents. It was a quick, but needful trip and my first since arriving in New Zealand 19 months ago. While I was there, Eric had an MRI done that revealed cancer at the base of his cerebellum and is sitting on the spine. While it is inoperable, the doctors believe they can kill it with 85% success. Please pray for my brother Eric. He is saved, and his attitude is amazing. He has not lost his testimony over this but is giving God the glory. He is a young 55-year-old man, and I would sure love to have him around another 20 years. Please pray God will heal him.

Our mid-winter family fun night in June was a success and ended in an all-out “snowball” fight using Styrofoam balls. And I got dog piled. What a night! In a few weeks, on October 31, we will have another Family Fun Night, and the theme is Tropical. These activities with our church are done to help build relationships between us and them and each other. While we do have great fun, we also have a time of devotion from God's Word.
